Project Faraday



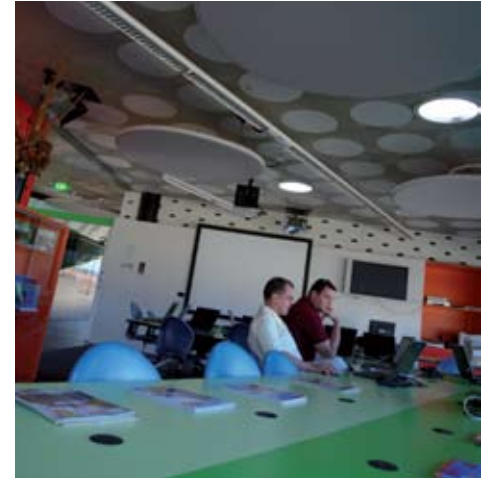
As part of the Governments Building Schools for the Future (BSF) programme, Project Faraday was established to advance the take up of the sciences within secondary schools and colleges, by intergrating scientific principles within the buidling structures themselves, promoting learning outside the classroom as well as affording more flexible learning zones.

Working side-by-side with White Design, an envrionmental architects practice based in Bristol, we were allocated two schools to work with, Bideford College in Devon and Joseph Rowntree School in York.

We facilitated workshops engaging with students, staff and the wider community, alongside other creative practitioners, educational specialists and visual artists, to bring their ideas to life, producing innovative and fully costed proposals to be funded by the DSF, as well as helping the creation of detailed architectural plans and digital fly-throughs.

We also designed and produced the final reports and accompanying DVD to spread the lessons learnt, which included observations from our overseas visit to Adelaide and Melbourne, South Australia.
