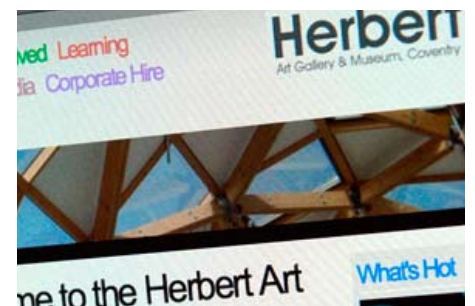
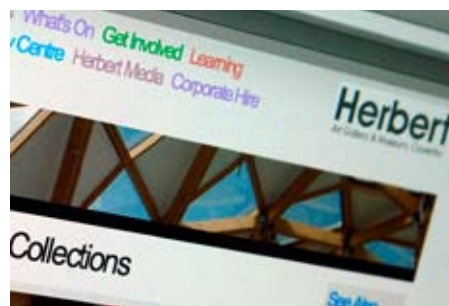
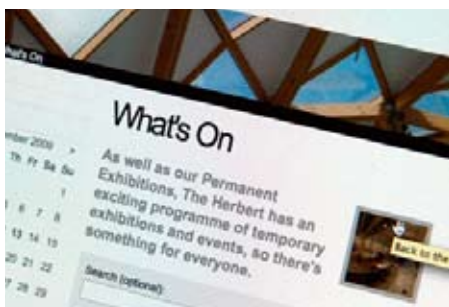
To mark the opening of a major refurbishment and extension of the Herbert Art Gallery & Museum, we were asked to tender for the redevelopment of their website.

So having successfully won the tender late 2007, we sat about the task of coding the fully accessible, front-end content managed site, to accommodate the vast collections they wished to place on-line, whilst keeping the navigation intuitive and the design clean and appealing.

The functionality of the site has been custom built, so no compromises have needed to be made, as would have been the case for an off-the-shelf solution. It also means that the management and maintenance of the site is as simple and intuitive as could be, with varying degrees of accessibility, depending on the provided security level prescribed in the users log-in.

Additional pages can easily be inserted, the order can be instantly changed, and as the site is built using style sheets, the whole look of the site can be changed in just a few clicks - depending on permissions of course...

The site also allows individuals to create their own virtual collection and even share these using social networking sites or email.
