Having tendered to produce an exhibition and learning zone for the new £2.6million Dalby Forest Visitor Centre, to explain the key eco-features of the building, we were keen to keep the focus on the audience and ensure the message was put across in a way that would engage, entertain and inform.

Interactive displays were installed alongside fixed display boards, featuring; a model village with a bellow-powered wind turbine to light up the houses; an interactive toilet; solar panels, a wood burning stove; a discovery compost bin; and a Solar Powered Green Man, complete with roving eyes, spinning fruit and a protruding tongue.

Our brief increased to produce large banners for the atrium, a digital projector and screen showing a day in the life of the forest and an external interactive map highlighting the different activities within the forest.

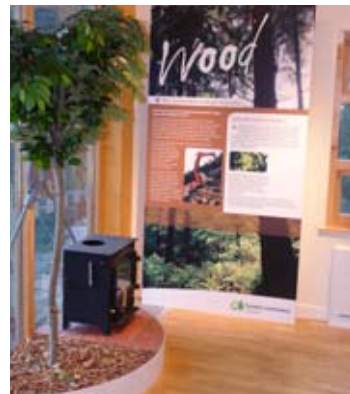
